

Castle Hill Explorer Scouts Fireworks Briefing 2019

Times/Dates	Saturday 2 nd November at 0900 to Sunday 3 rd November at 1300
Report/Depart	Christchurch Park, Westerfield Road Gate
Uniform	Unit Scarf only
Wear	Strong boots, warm old clothing, waterproofs, gloves
Kit Required	Normal for a weekend camp. No knives please.
Food	The following meals will be provided: Saturday Lunch, Saturday Supper & Sunday Breakfast
Camping Equip.	Tent(s) inc. flysheet, groundsheet., etc. All other kit will be onsite.
Objective	To work together as a team and with other teams to assist the leaders and organisers to ensure that the firework display is a safe and successful event.
Rules	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1) Normal scout camping rules apply.2) Nobody is to leave the site, without a leader's permission.3) Personal kit, tent and all other camp equipment should be clean and packed away by 9.30am on Sunday 3rd November.4) All explorer scouts to wear the 'Castle Hill Explorers' HV jacket during the whole event.5) No Explorer Scouts are to ride in the backs of trucks at any time.6) Any unacceptable behaviour will be dealt with by grounding at the 'camp' area and will be banned from attending any further firework events as an Explorer Scout.7) Explorer Scouts should return to the 'camp' area by 10.30pm at the latest.
Duties	<p>Set up and take down tasks will be assigned on Saturday morning.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Make up and fix First Aid and Toilets sign system.• Fill up water carriers.• Fix all admission signs at entrance gates.• Assist with general duties.

During the event (16.00 to 22.00)

Some Explorer Scouts may be asked to assist with some tasks under **direct supervision**. These will be approached individually and **will not** be allowed to wear a yellow HV jacket during the event period.

Due to rules imposed upon us by the Ipswich Borough Council who 'own' the park and are the enforcement agency for health and safety regulations, we are unable to allow Explorer scouts to carry out many tasks during the event times (16.00 to 22.00) without direct supervision, those that remain unallocated will be free to enjoy the event, reporting back to the camp area by 10.30pm.
